ORDINANCE NO. 2020-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD, TEXAS, ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD AND REPEALING AND REPLACING ALL OTHER FEE SCHEDULES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Weatherford desires to provide a single and convenient location for a list of all fees charged by the City of Weatherford; and

WHEREAS, such list is intended to repeal and replace all existing fees in conflict with the fee schedule listed on Exhibit A attached and incorporated as part of this Ordinance, save and except water and wastewater impact fees which are wholly contained in a separate Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD, TEXAS:

<u>Findings of Fact.</u> The above and foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein as findings of fact. The City Council further finds and determines that the rules, regulations, terms, conditions, provisions and requirements of this ordinance are reasonable and necessary to protect the public health, safety and quality of life in the City.

Repeal and replacement of existing fees. The City Council hereby repeals and replaces all fees levied by the City of Weatherford in conflict with the fee schedule attached and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A." Said repeal and replacement shall be effective on April 1, 2020.

<u>Future Amendments to the adopted fee schedule.</u> The City Council hereby authorizes amendments to the fee schedule listed in "Exhibit A" by minute order of the City Council.

Resolution of Conflicting Ordinances. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency between this ordinance and any other code or ordinance of the City, save and except the provisions of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance, and the Water and Wastewater Impact Fee Ordinance the provisions of this ordinance shall control. Nothing adopted herein is intended to, in any way, nor shall any such provision be deemed to supersede or control over the provisions of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance or the Water and Wastewater Impact Fee Ordinance.

<u>Savings Clause.</u> All rights and remedies of the City of Weatherford are expressly saved as to any and all provisions of any ordinance affecting fees of the City and to any and all violations of the provisions of any prior ordinance pertaining to animal control and regulations within the City which have accrued as of the effective date of this ordinance; and as to such accrued fees, collection

activity, violations and any pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not, under such prior ordinances, same shall not be affected by this ordinance but may be prosecuted and pursued until final disposition by the courts.

<u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accord with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code.

Severability. It is the express intent of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, sentence, paragraph or section should be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance as the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section. If any provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Open Meetings. The City Council finds and determines that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was duly given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act.
